

Bluebonnet Brahman Breeder Association Scholarship Application

The Bluebonnet Brahman Breeders Association is pleased to support the youth in the Brahman Breed by awarding scholarships to outstanding students graduating from high school and pursuing an advanced education. Scholarship amounts and number of recipients will be determined yearly by Bluebonnet committee.

All complete applications will be considered, regardless of the applicant's socio-economic status, race, color, sex, religion, national origin or disability. Recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Bluebonnet Brahman Breeder Association Board of Directors and shall be chosen from the applications received. Failure of a student awarded a BBBA scholarship to comply with the scholarship rules as stated herein shall automatically constitute forfeiture of the scholarship monies.

Application Guidelines:

Applications should be returned to the Bluebonnet Brahman Breeders Association no later than May 1st of the application year. Upon receipt, the applications will be reviewed by the Bluebonnet Brahman Breeders Association Board of Directors.

A check will be awarded to the winners after he/she presents evidence of enrollment as a full-time student in either a college or university in the fall semester following the award of the scholarship. Failure to enroll in the fall semester after graduation will result in forfeiture of any right to the scholarship award.

Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from an accredited high school or approved home school curriculum.
2. Applicants must be an active member of the American Junior Brahman Association (AJBA).
3. Applicant must furnish an official school transcript with GPA from high school attended.
4. Provide (2) letters of recommendation
5. Provide ACT/SAT Scores
6. Scholarship applications must be post marked before **May 1st** deadline to be considered.

Instructions:

All scholarship applications should be typewritten using a typewriter, word processor or computer. Pages may be added to the scholarship form if needed and should directly follow the page in which the question appears. Staple the applications before mailing to ensure the pages stay in order.

Your application must include two letters of recommendations. The letters should include your association with the individuals writing the recommendation along with a candid evaluation of your abilities, background, character, strengths, etc. The recommendation may come from employers, teachers, ag leaders, junior advisors, pastors, etc. Recommendations may not include parents or Bluebonnet Brahman Breeders Directors.

May 1st is the absolute deadline for mailing all applications. **Faxed copies will not be accepted.**
Note: With regard to this deadline, materials mailed must be postmarked by the U. S. Postal Service on or before May 1st.
