Welcome to the 2024 Ark-La-Miss Fair Livestock Show sponsored by the West Monroe Civitan Club. The show is being held at our new Ark-La-Miss Fair home, the IKE Hamilton Exposition Center at 501 Mane St., West Monroe, La.

Our first weekend features the American Brahman Breeders Association (ABBA) Points Show on Saturday, Sept. 28, 2024. The annual swine show will be Thursday, Oct. 3 and the annual Open/4-H Livestock Show on Oct. 5, featuring cattle, goats and lambs.

The ABBA cattle will be admitted starting Thursday, Sept. 26. (Any special arrangements needed, please contact us.) The Market Hogs will be admitted Sept. 30 to the pavilion adjacent to the IKE Hamilton Arena. They will be weighed, starting at 6 pm Sept. 26. The Show will begin promptly at 9 am Sept. 28 with Showmanship, followed by judging.

All the cattle showing the second weekend of the fair will be allowed to enter the pavilion on Friday, Oct. 4 or they can come on Saturday. The Oct. 5 cattle show will begain at 9 am following weighing at 7 am. Showmanship will be conducted first, with Judging starting afterwards. Lambs and goat weigh-in wil begin at 10 am Oct. 5 with judging set to begin after the cattle show, around 2 pm. Judging can be held earlier depending on the timeline.

Although this is an open show our emphasis is on the Juniors, FFA and 4-H members.

NEW THIS YEAR: Each exhibitor during the week will be responsirble for purchasing shavings from the IKE Hamilton staff at \$10/bag. None will be provided by the Ark-La-Miss Fair staff.

We look forward to another great year at the Ark-La-Miss Fair Livestock Show and another great opportunity to visit with our exhibitors.

ABBA OFFICIAL FALL 2024 SHOW CLASSES

(For ABBA APPROVED SHOWS occurring between July 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024)

Subject to the immediately following ABBA Official Show Class Special Conditions, Animals exhibited at both Sponsored and Sanctioned American Brahman Breeders Association ("ABBA") Open Shows shall be presented for judging as Grey Brahman and Red Brahmans classifications within the Official Classes and Divisions set out herein below:

ABBA OFFICIAL SHOW CLASS SPECIAL CONDITIONS

A. All Animals exhibited must be registered with the American Brahman Breeders Association ("ABBA") and be appropriately fire branded as provided by ABBA requirements for registration in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook.

- B. All Animals exhibited are subject to the ABBA Color Classification Rules as established from time to time. A copy of the most current ABBA Color Classification Rules may be obtained from the ABBA.
- C. All animals exhibited are subject to the ABBA DNA Verification Rules as established from time to time. A copy of the most current ABBA DNA Verification Rules may be obtained from the ABBA.
- D. All Females exhibited in the **Senior Division** must either [1] be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy issued by a licensed veterinarian (within 90 days prior to the date of the Show) certifying the Animal is pregnant and such certificate shall be made available for inspection and verification upon request, [2] be in a lactating stage and have her natural, nursing calf at side, which Calf has not exceeded 240 days old as of the date of the Show, or [3] have weaned her natural calf which Calf is registered in the

ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and the Calfs registration certificate is available for inspection and verification upon request.

- E. All Females exhibited in the **Aged Senior Division** must either [1] be in a lactating stage and have her natural, nursing calf at side which Calf has not exceeded 240 days old as of the date of the Show, or [2] have weaned her natural calf which Calf is registered in the ABBA Official Brahman Herdbook and the Calf s registration certificate is available for inspection and verification upon request.
- F. All Bulls must be exhibited with a permanent or temporary nose ring with an appropriate lead attached.
- G. All Bulls exhibited in the **Senior and Aged Senior Divisions** must be accompanied by a valid, satisfactory Breeding Soundness Exam (BSE) certification issued by a licensed veterinarian (within one year prior to the date of the Show) and such certification shall be made available for inspection and verification upon request.
- H. All Animals in the **Calf and Junior Yearling Divisions** which have been previously disqualified from being exhibited at an ABBA Approved Show based on not meeting Weights and Measures Parameters may not be exhibited at another ABBA Approved Show until such time as [1] the Animal re-qualifies by meeting Weights and Measures Parameters at a subsequent ABBA Approved Show where weights and measures are taken, or [2] the Animal is no longer being exhibited in the Calf or Junior Yearling Divisions at ABBA Approved Shows.
- I. All **Group Classes** will be exhibited at the beginning of the ABBA Approved Show prior to any individual classes being exhibited in such Show. All individual Animals exhibited in Group Classes must be presented by an individual Showman for each participating Animal for the Group to be placed by the Judge(s).
- J. All Animals exhibited in the Get of Sire, Natural Produce of Dam and Embryo Produce of Dam Group Classes at an ABBA Approved

Show must be exhibited under the registered color of the represented Sire or Dam; NOT the color of the progeny comprising the Group. The Breeders Genetic Group and Breeder's Herd shall be exhibited under the registered color of the individual Animals (which all must be registered as the same color) comprising the Group.

K. All Classes which exceed more than fifteen (15) Animals MAY be broken into smaller Classes each no larger than 15 Animals, at the sole discretion of Show Management, by dividing the Classes as evenly as possible without splitting Animals with the same birth date. Additional Classes resulting from splitting Classes shall be treated as new individual Classes (and not as heats of a single Class) for purposes of class placings, competition within Divisions, and ABBA Register of Renown Points awarded.

GROUPS

ALL GROUP CLASSES SHALL BE EXHIBITED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE ABBA APPROVED SHOW PRIOR TO ANY INDIVIDUAL CLASSES BEING EXHIBITED.

- G1. PRODUCE OF DAM Two (2) natural born Animals both produced by the same Dam, either or both sexes may be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Dam. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G2. EMBRYO PRODUCE OF DAM Two (2) Animals both produced by the same Dam via embryo transfer, either or both sexes may be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Dam. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G3. GET OF SIRE Four (4) Animals all by the same Sire from at least two different Dams, both sexes must be represented. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No ownership requirement for the participating individual Animals in the Group. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Sire. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judge(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.
- G4. BREEDER'S GENETIC GROUP-Three (3) genetically similar Animals all by the same Sire and same Dam, either or both sexes may be represented. All individual Animals comprising this Group shall be registered with the ABBA as the same color and shall be exhibited based on the color of the individual Animals comprising

the Group as registered with the ABBA. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. No single Exhibitor shall be permitted to show more than one entry per Sire and Dam mating combination. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judges(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class.

BREEDER'S HERD - Four (4) Animals, G5. both sexes must be represented. All individual Animals comprising this Group must have the same (Breeder's) holding brand. All individual Animals comprising this Group shall be registered with the ABBA as the same color and shall be exhibited based on the color of the individual Animals comprising the Group as registered with the ABBA. Each Animal in the Group must also be exhibited in the appropriate individual Class for such Animal. All entries in this Class must be placed by the Judges(s). There will be named a Champion and Reserve Champion of this Group Class. NO REGISTER OF RENOWN POINTS SHALL BE AWARDED FOR THIS GROUP CLASS.

GENERAL RULES

SECTION 1. The Ark-LA-Miss Livestock Show reserves to the rules and regulations committee the final and absolute rights to interpret, amend, or add to the rules and regulations in regard thereto connected with or incident to the show. In the event of conflict of general rules and special rules, the latter will govern. These rules will apply to each and every department of the show, and exhibitors and concessionaires are required to familiarize themselves with all rules. Any person who violates any of the following general or special rules will forfeit all privileges and premiums and will be subject to such penalty as the rules and regulations committee may order.

SECTION 2. Animals entered must be owned by exhibitor thirty days prior to the opening date of the show. All exhibitors of Breeding Stock must be prepared to show certificates of registry within their respective associations.

SECTION 3. No substitution of any animal will be allowed after the entries are officially closed.

LIABILITY OF EXHIBITORS

SECTION 1. All property of every character entered for competition display or other purposes, or being anywhere on the exhibit grounds will be subject to the control of the manager of the Ark-La-Miss Livestock Show.

SECTION 2. In no case shall the Ark-La-Miss Livestock Show, or the manager, or any other official or employee, be held responsible for any loss, damage or death, by disease or otherwise of any character to any person, property, or exhibit while en route to, from or while same is on exhibit grounds.

SECTION 3. If the property owners, or other interested in the property, desire protection against loss, damages, or injury, they must make their own arrangements for carrying insurance and paying the premiums.

REMOVAL OF OBJECTIONABLE EXHIBITS AND DISPLAYS

If it be ascertained that any exhibitor or his employee has in any ungentlemanly and public manner taken exception to the judgement of the ruling judge, the superintendent or any other official of the Ark-La-Miss Livestock Show, the rules and regulations committee may expel the exhibitor or employee so offending from competition for premiums or exhibiting on the grounds of the show until he shall have made the proper apology and has been reinstated as an exhibitor by the rules committee.

If it be ascertained that an exhibitor has knowingly caused to be made or made any false statements in regard to any animals or articles, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he shall be excluded from competition on the exhibition grounds.

The Superintendent shall exclude livestock from the competition should there be any unnecessary or embarrassing delay on the part of the exhibitor in bringing animals into the show ring or to show their animals at such times as may be directed or required.

The management reserves the right to remove from the grounds any exhibit, animals, or concession that may be falsely entered and may be deemed unsuitable or objectionable or to remove any sign, banner, or advertising matter of any kind, which may be deemed unsuitable or objectionable by them without assigning a reason therefore, and if necessary to return any money paid for space or stalls, which will exonerate it from any claims whatsoever on the part of the exhibitor or purchaser.

LIVESTOCK HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All livestock moving into Northeast Louisiana must meet current federal and Louisiana interstate regulation specified by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture Livestock Sanitary Board, Baton Rouge, LA 70804.

HEALTH PAPERS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL ANIMALS.

SUPERINTENDENT STATEMENT

The superintendent has the final authority and responsibility for the interpretation and enforcement of the rules of his division during the judging of the show.

RULE X PROTEST AND APPEALS

SECTION 1. All protests must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. The protest must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal, and must be filed with the general manager within two hours of the completion of the judging.

SECTION 2. Appeals from the decision of the judge or superintendent in charge must be made within two hours after the award has been made and attested to by a Notary Public. It must contain at least one specific charge stating at length all facts relied upon or the rules violated. This statement must also contain witnesses and their addresses by which proof is to be made.

BEEF CATTLE

BREED SPECIAL RULES

- 1. The registration certificate (or photocopy) for each entry must be available for representation to the superintendent or manager of the show at the time entries are verified prior to judging.
- The registration number and animal identification number (number branded on animal) of each animal must be entered in an individual class.
- 3. Entries will be listed numerically according to age (youngest first) in catalogs and judging schedules. Include animal identification number (number brand) as a part of identification. When entering the arena for judging the handlers will line cattle up numerically in the same order.
- Judges will be allowed to comment on placings in selected classes when conditions permit.
- 5. Any animal found to have had its physical features altered or tampered with by surgical instruments for the purpose of improving its conformation or appearance in the show ring will be disqualified and ruled ineligible to compete for or retain any premiums. (Surgical dehorn not included.)
- 6. All animals' tattoos will be checked for legibility and must match the registration papers for that animal. Animals will illegible tattoos or incorrect papers will not be allowed to show. Checking tattoos is the responsibility of the Ark-La-Miss Livestock Show.
- 7. To maintain a high degree of confidence in the Beef show, the Ark-La-Miss Show reserves the right to disqualify any animal that has been fitted in an unethical manner. Unethical fitting shall include the following:
- a) Any altering of the natural color of the animal by use of dyes, paints, coloring hair conditions, colored show foam, graphite, colored powders, or any other substances.
- b) The addition of any hair or hair-like substances, including false tailheads and false polls. False tail switches are allowed.
- c) The cutting, tearing or gluing of the hide or underneath the hide or removal of tissue in an attempt to alter the shape of the animal.
- d) The injection of any gas, solid, or liquid under the hide to alter the normal conformation.
- e) Any attempts to disrupt or change the normal dental development of the animal.
- f) Any products administered internally or externally to alter the conformation of the animal such as steroids and growth stimulants are prohibited.
- 8. All bulls must show with a nose-lead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show superintendent and the show management.
- 9. A breed must have a minimum of 10 animals to have a class. The 4 breeds with the most entries will have their own classes. The rest will show as AOB Non Brahman or AOB Brahman Influenced.
- 10. All decisions by Show Committee will be final.

COMMERCIAL HEIFER SHOW

Commercial Heifers must have two temporary incisor teeth (Baby teeth) in place day of the show.

Heifer must polled or dehorned; scars or regrowth cannot exceed 1 1/2 inches.

Registered heifers are not eligible for the Commercial Heifer Show.
